

## **Tuesday Evening Social Event Tillicum Village / Blake Island**

The adventure to Tillicum Village begins by taking a bus to Pier 55 on Seattle's Central Waterfront. Then you will relax and enjoy the magnificent scenery during the one-hour cruise to Blake Island State Park located 8 miles from Seattle's Central Waterfront.

Upon arrival you will be welcomed by a path strewn with white clamshells bleached by the sun and greeted with an appetizer of steaming clams in nectar broth.

Inside the longhouse, watch as whole Chinook salmon is cooked over an alder-wood fire on cedar stakes in the traditional Northwest Coast Indian style.

Your meal is served buffet-style and includes a menu of Traditional Indian-style Baked Salmon, Warm Tillicum Whole Grain Bread, New Red Potatoes, Long-Grain Wild Rice, Fresh Salad Bar, Boehm's Chocolate Salmon, Coffee, Tea, Lemonade.

As you finish your meal, the lights dim while the myth and magic come to life in the spellbinding performance featuring the Tillicum Village dancers.

After the show, you have approximately 30 minutes of free time when you can watch carving demonstrations in the longhouse, visit the gift gallery featuring artwork of local artisans or stroll along the pristine beaches and many forested trails.
