Meeting Notes of IEEE WG E2 October 19, 2010– Nashville

1. Introductions

It was also suggested that we investigate setting up an on-line survey. Matt Bauer will be asked to continue to follow through with the revised survey.

4. IEEE 980 Review Assignments

An overview of the content of IEEE 980 was conducted. No changes to the outline structure were suggested at this time. All members are to review the entire standard. Working group members were assigned to review a specific section of the standard as follows: References – Jim Sosinski Definitions – Jim Sosinski Statutory requirements – Diane Watkins Oil spill sources – Joe Gravelle Criteria – Brian Wallace Containment – Mike McNulty Control and Cleanup – Don Wengerter

Each person will review their section and submit a "Word" document with tracked changes to Jim Sosinski by March 1, 2011. Jim will pull together all the changes into one document for submittal to members for review and discussion at the next meeting in May of 2011 in Chicago.

5. Other Discussion

A question was raised by a guest regarding the criteria for requiring oil containment for a substation associated with a wind power project. Various members of the working group addressed the question.
