# Meeting Notes of IEEE WG E2 May 17, 2011 – Chicago

The group developed a plan to have a live meeting webinar the first Tuesday of each month to review the standard. Matt Bauer will set this up and schedule the meetings. We also discussed the possibility of having a a stand-alone 2 to 3 day meeting to wrap up the revisions after all survey data is compiled and once pass is made through the standard.
