Smøla Wind Farm is a 68 turbine wind farm located in the municipality of <u>Smøla</u> in <u>Møre og Romsdal</u> county, Norway and operated by Statkraft. The farm is located southeast of <u>Dyrnes</u> on the island of Smøla. The farm covers an area of 18 square kilometers (6.9 sq mi).

Total installed capacity is 20 x 2.0 <u>MW</u> (phase one) plus 48 x 2.3 MW (phase two). The maximum production capacity is 150 MW and total generating capacity is in average 450 <u>GWh</u> per year, making Smøla the largest wind farm in the country and the largest onshore wind farm in Europe.
