Teaching Electricity & Circuits	8*7 = 56 hrs	Fall	Teach electricity and circuits to 423 seventh graders for 6 class periods and tell them what electrical and computer engineers do. We also brought the Robotics Team (several are members of both organizations) providing a robot demonstration. In teaching we used a PowerPoint and several props - bringing several pieces of electronics that we have taken apart to show the insides and they work. We bring Christmas lights to explain series and parallel circuits, etc. Keeping 400 seventh grader's attention for longer than 15 minutes is a challenge, but we did it.
