Dr. Mark Maybury is Executive Director of MITRE's Information Technology Division. He is responsible for the direction of advanced research and development for intelligence and defense systems supporting a broad range of sponsors including the U.S. Air Force, Army, Navy, OSD, DISA, DARPA, NSF, and national intelligence agencies. In addition, his division provides research and modernization to the IRS and FAA.

Dr. Maybury serves on the Board of Directors of the Object Management Group (1999-present) and the Air Force Scientific Advisory Board (2007-2011). Mark served on the Air Force Scientific Advisory Board Study on Commercial Space (2000-2001), the National Space System Architect senior advisory panel (2001), and the Defense Science Board Task Forces on Defense Software (2000), Information Management for Net-Centric Operations (2006), Strategic Communication (2007), Human Dynamics (2008) and Information Technology Acquisition (2008).

Mark has over sixty refereed publications.
