During his tenure at NYCT, he managed and ran capital and maintenance programs including procurement of 3,500 new technology subway cars, and development and implementation of advanced type maintenance regimes. Gene holds a BSEE from Kansas State University and MBA from Iona College, he is a published author, and adjunct professor at NYU lecturing transportation classes.

Janice Li. PE., is a Practice Lead at JACOBS' NYC Rail and Transit Engineering team. She specializes in management of transportation type projects with focus on asset management, strategic planning, system integration, O&M, and process improvement programs. Janice began her transit career at Amtrak 26-years ago, where she served in various engineering positions. Her recent projects include an oversight of P3, DBOM, and Design-Build programs. Janice holds a BS in Industrial Engineering and MBA, including an American Society for Quality (ASQ) Certified Six Sigma Black Belt, and Envision Sustainability Professional (ENV SP) Certificate by Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure.
