Authors are invited to submit a 1000-word (2 or 3 pages) extended abstract, summarizing an original work finalized or in progress, directly to ICACT2009 website. All the manuscripts must be written in English, but can be prepared in free style. All submitted extended abstracts will be reviewed by the technical program committee. For the review, the extended abstracts in MS-WORD or PDF file should be submitted to the ICACT2009 conference website (<http://www.icact.org>), filling every item and uploading the respective extended abstract.

After you win the acceptance notification, you will prepare the final camera-ready manuscript of maximum six(6) IEEE double-column formatted pages, the Copyright Transfer Agreement, and the Speaker's Biography together.
