

# IEEE Humanitarian Technology Programs-Long Term

- Provide the capability for people at the BOP to access needed sustainable humanitarian technologies:
  - Long term role of IEEE in the development of sustainable humanitarian solutions
  - To improve the quality of life at the BOP
- Provide for economic growth that will enable people at BOP to chose solutions to the basic needs of food, health, shelter, education, and security

## **Providers of Services at BOP**

- Many organizations are providing services largely determined by available resources
- Services in a BOP community:
  - Information, food, health, security, sustainable growth environment
  - Government: basic services
  - Foundations-NGO's: focused projects
  - Industries-Entrepreneurs: local opportunities




- Historically- IEEE has fostered technological innovation and excellence for the benefit of humanity
  - 125 years- Edison, Bell, Westinghouse
  - Promote growth of industry through the exchange of information to address unmet needs
- Provide access to technology information -TAB, standards, OU's, conferences, publications, member experiences(GHN)
- Major asset-global membership and their relationships with industry

- Humanitarian Technology Projects-Innovative solutions to unmet humanitarian needs in BOP communities
- Goal-Sustainable access with fiscal base
- -Transfer solutions to other global communities
- Need-Process to assure the economic sustainability of the successful solutions
- An industry or other for-profit center to sustain the continued availability of the humanitarian product or service

# Bridging The Gap Sustainable Solutions

- Shift from project funding to profit funding
- Cost of providing a product or service:
  - Development of technology
  - Overhead to produce and deliver
  - Potential profit
- Consider the BOP:
  - People have commerce and experience
  - Micro-lending, Micro-banking
  - Local culture
