The chapter has been formed because of the approximately 200 IEEE members in the Central Area (Wellington and Palmerston North), about 50 of these are members of one of the three societies: Communications, Signal Processing and Information Theory. Treasurer: The Section has generously given us NZ\$500 to help us start. This is held jointly with the Section accounts, held by staff at Massey Palmerston North (Gourab Sen Gupta), so it makes sense for Xiang at PN to be treasurer. We will be able to gain US\$200 annually from IEEE. To raise further funds we obviously need to hold events.
