

## Report on IEEE Travel Award Recipient

**APCC** – Asia Pacific Conference on Communications, is an international IEEE conference. This conference is being organised in the area of Telecommunication Technologies and services annually in South East Asian Countries. This year the 11<sup>th</sup> conference was held in Perth, Western Australia during October 3-5<sup>th</sup>, 2005 in Hyatt Hotel. There were totally 395 submissions from 26 nations from all over the world. After tough reviews by 3 experts in the area of Telecommunications, only 232 papers were accepted for oral presentation. The conference was held in five to six parallel sessions.

The paper entitled “Congestion Management of Self Similar IP Traffic using Probability based Normal and Exponential Marking RED” by Suresh. S and Göl Özdemir, from School of Electrical and Information Engineering, University of South Australia, was one among the accepted papers. Suresh presented this paper on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2005 in the session on Teletraffic Management and Control, which was chaired by Dr. Richard Hall of

RMIT, Melbourne. The presentation received good commendation from the delegates and the ensuing questions about the research idea presented were fully answered.

Suresh found the papers presented in the conference were very interesting and informative. He also had an opportunity to get to know various people working in his research area of Telecommunications from different countries.

Suresh found the Travel award very helpful for him to go and present his paper in the conference and also get to know people working in different areas of his research. This he finds very helpful for building up his research career in the subject area of Telecommunications.
