Gary Crisp CPEng, MIEAust, CEng, MICE, MAIPM, PMP has been involved with Corporation desalination projects for 6 years. He spent 7 months in the UK with a major



desalination contractor (Weir Westgarth) and had input into the design of the world's first large Seawater RO plant with UF pretreatment (Kindasa). He was the Corporation's design manager seconded to Multiplex Degremont JV during the project development stage of the Perth Desalination Project. The Multiplex Degremont JV was recently awarded the contract.

Gary prepared the Corporation's desalination strategy and associated report in 2000.

Gary has been an integral member of all teams involved in desalination (thermal and membrane separation), including the Perth Seawater Desalination Project, Burrup Fertilisers Project, the

Kwinana Water Reuse Plant and numerous small RO plants.

Gary is a member of the International Desalination Association and presented at the world forum on many occasions. He is a Director of the Australasian Desalination Association.

Gary was appointed as peer reviewer for desalination planning in NSW. He assisted BHP Billiton in the selection of the process and contractor for their new thermal plant that will be supporting the \$2 billion Ravensthorpe Nickel Project. He is currently advising Gold Coast Water in desalination.

Gary was recently appointed to head the Water Corporation's new Desalination Centre of Expertise Section.
