Requirements are not difficult

- Substantial job responsibilities such as **team leader, task supervisor, engineer in charge of a program or project, engineer or scientist performing research with some measure of success (papers),** or faculty developing and teaching courses with research and publications, all are indications of significant performance well as the following:
 - **Substantial engineering, responsibility or achievement**
 - **Publication of engineering or scientific papers, books or inventions**
 - **Technical direction or management of important scientific or engineering work with evidence of accomplishment**
 - **Recognized contributions to the welfare of the scientific or engineering profession**
 - **Development or furtherance of important scientific or engineering courses in a program on the**
 - **Contributions equivalent to those of (a) to (e) above in areas such as technical editing, patent prosecution or patent law, provided these contributions serve to advance progress**
