Old Business

- LVS boundaries. Minear circulated a chart showing counties which according to IEEE headquarters are part of LVS, and pointed out that LVS doesn't include each entire county. Closed.
- Linked-In Group for LVS/SSCS. Peruzzi reported the group is created and available. Until 100% participation in that group is achieved it cannot serve as an official portal for announcements or notices. Closed.

New Business and Discussion

1. Kickoff Meeting preparations:

- a. Group discussion about the need to begin advertising the even as soon as possible, and about Friday night's being a poor choice from the standpoint of attracting an audience. Peruzzi agreed to ask for Tom Lee's lecture topic and suggest he select a Monday instead, pointing out the probability of a larger audience including student members, and that Monday still allows for a weekend in New York or Philadelphia in conjunction with the trip.
- **b. Discussion:** Need to decide date quickly and reserve room at Lehigh, send out invitation message and ask for an early RSVP. **Peruzzi** to check the Lehigh academic calendar and follow up with Lehigh professors to arrange for meeting room.

- c. Discussion: All agreed Pizza and soft drinks would be appropriate for meeting, but we ought to see what was done by other chapters for their kickoff meeting. Peruzzi to ask SSCS Headquarters for suggested program formats.
- **d. Discussion:** Travel arrangements and accommodations for **Tom Lee**. Consensus was that his administrative assistant will probably take care of this, but we will of course offer help
- e. Discussion: Whom to invite to kickoff meeting? Consensus: All of LVS, Electrical Engineering students and faculty, IEEE Student branches from other colleges affiliated with LVS and SSCS chapters from neighboring sections. Also invite Engineering managers from local companies whether IEEE members or not. Peruzzi to learn student branch contacts and neighboring SSCS chapter contacts. All to suggest local industry guests to invite

- iii. Inclusion of IEEE student branches. **Ian Rippke** to inquire about local IEEE student branch coordinators and activities.
- iv. Newsletter by email. **Peruzzi** and **Rippke** agreed to provide content, and to seek content from others as well. No specific target date for first edition.
- v. No admission charges
- vi. Free food
