Prof. Sung-Jea Ko received his Ph.D. degree in 1988 and his MS degree in 1986, both in Electrical and Computer Engineering, from State University of New York at Buffalo, and the BS degree in Electronic Engineering from Korea University in 1980. In 1992, he joined the Department of Electronic Engineering at Korea University, where he is currently a professor and the Head of the School of Electrical Engineering. He has conducted numerous research projects in the fields of signal and image processing and communications.

He has contributed more than 310 articles to journals and conference proceedings, co-authored four textbooks, and holds more than 20 patents on video signal processing including digital camera applications.

Dr. Ko is a Senior Member of the IEEE, a Fellow of the IEE, a Chartered Engineer of the IEE, and the chairman of the Consumer Electronic chapter of IEEE Korea Council. He has served as a vice-president of Signal Processing Society of the Institute of Electronics Engineers of Korea, IEEK (2004 - present). He was a TPC chair of ISPACS (2005).

He was the Special Sessions chair for the IEEE Asia Pacific Conference on Circuits and Systems (1996). He has served as an Associate Editor for several technical journals. He received the Academic Research award from Korea University (2004), the LG Research Award (1999), the Hae-Dong best paper award from the IEEK (1997), the best paper award from the IEEE Asia Pacific Conference on Circuits and Systems (1996), and the Rackham Research Initiation Award from the University of Michigan (1991). His current research interests are in the areas of digital signal and image processing, and multimedia communications.

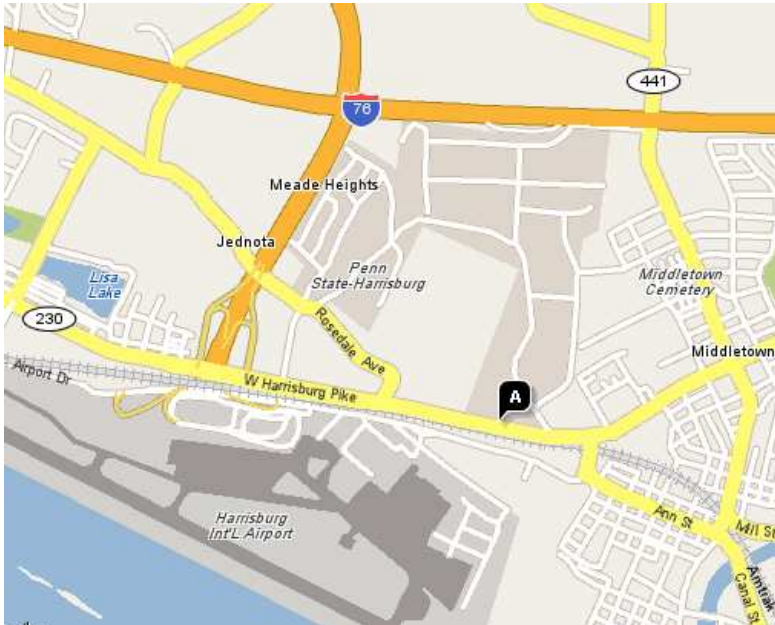
Directions
