Direction

From Lebanon city center: From Route 72 (9th St) and Route 422 (Cumberland St), drive north on Route 72 for 3.0 miles to Heisey's Diner. Continue on Route 72 for 0.2 miles and turn left onto Heilmandale Rd. Continue on Heilmandale Rd for 0.8 miles to Russell Rd. Turn left onto Russell Rd and drive 0.7 miles to the GLRA site, and look for a sign "Maintenance, Operations, Engineering" on the left, which is the entrance and parking lot for the facility.

Directions from Annville town square: From the square (Route 934 and Route 422), drive north on Route 934 for 1.3 miles to Hill Church Rd. Turn right onto Hill Church RD and drive 1.7 miles to Russell Rd. Turn left on Russell Rd and drive 1.4 miles to the GLRA site. Turn right at the sign "Maintenance, Operations, Engineering" which is the entrance and parking lot.
