David will talk about present day IT evidence collection from computers taken in police raids. He will explain how the information is copied and made ready for presentation to the Pennsylvania State-Wide Investigative Grand Jury. David will go over the use of special computer software and its use in criminal investigations.

David G. Buckwash is a special agent for the Computer Forensics Unit, Bureau of Investigative Services, Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (OAG). His responsibilities include seizing and conducting forensic examinations of suspect computer systems in criminal investigation cases and training law enforcement officers in dealing with digital evidence in high technology investigations. Prior to coming to the Computer Forensics Unit, he investigated insurance fraud cases for the OAG Insurance Fraud Section within thirty-two (32) counties in Central Pennsylvania. In addition to these duties, Mr. Buckwash was an adjunct instructor at Harrisburg Area Community College.

Prior to his employment with the OAG, Mr. Buckwash was a Special Investigator for General Accident Insurance Company. Prior to that, he was a police officer in Dauphin County for almost fifteen (15 years).

Mr. Buckwash received his Master of Education degree from Penn State University. He also holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Penn State University. He has also received specialized training at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Brunswick Georgia in financial crimes investigation and law enforcement video training. Mr. Buckwash has also completed the Law of Claims Fraud Investigation and Defense and the Legal Principles courses offered by the American Educational institute as well as completing the N.I.C.B. Academy in October, 1993.

Directions

The Harrisburg Campus of ITT Technical Institute is located at the corner of Eisenhower Blvd and Paxton Street, on the ground floor of the Belco Credit Union Building. Park in the back parking lot (opposite Eisenhower Blvd and toward the Harrisburg Mall). Enter through the door marked "Student Entrance" and follow the signs to the IEEE Meeting.

From PA Turnpike (I-76): Get off at exit 247 (Harrisburg East). Take I-283 North to Exit 2, Swatara. At the top of the ramp, turn left on Lindle Road. Turn right on Eisenhower Blvd. Go approximately ¾ mile and turn left into ITT Tech.

From West via Rout 581: Take Route 581-East to I-83 North. Take Exit 45 toward Paxton Street. Turn left on Paxton Street. At end of Paxton Street, turn right on Eisenhower Blvd.; then, make a right into ITT Tech.

Parking is free anywhere around the building. To enter, go to the student entrance for ITT-Technical Institute in the rear of the building. Signs will direct you from there.
