Directions

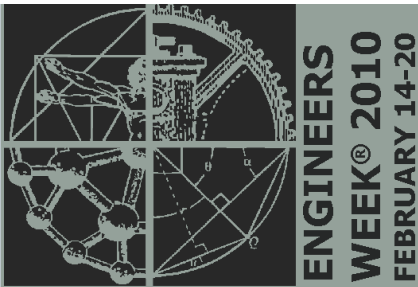
