SRBC is the governing agency established under a 100-year compact signed on December 24, 1970, by the federal government and the states of New York, Pennsylvania, and Maryland to protect and wisely manage the water resources of the Susquehanna River Basin. Commission staff focus on long-term sustainable utilization of the basin's shared water resources. Water management efforts strike a balance between beneficial development of the resource and safeguarding adequate flows for public water supplies, industries, agriculture and recreation, and the protection of aquatic life, habitat and water quality.
