**Directions**

**From York:** Travel on Route 30 East and exit at SR 441. Make a right onto Linden Street and then a left unto SR 441 south. Travel on SR 441 south and pass SR 999 and continue onto Water Street, which becomes River Road. Follow River Road for approx. 7 miles and turn right onto Powerhouse Road. Proceed to the Dam.

**From Lancaster:** Travel on Route 30 West and exit at SR 441. Make a left unto SR 441 south. Travel on SR 441 south and pass SR 999 and continue onto Water Street, which becomes River Road. Follow River Road for approx. 7 miles and turn right onto Powerhouse Road. Proceed to the Dam.

**From Camp Hill:** Follow I-83 to US 30 East., Exit onto SR 441 South. Pass SR 999 and continue onto Water Street, which continues as River Road (approximately 7 miles). Turn right onto Powerhouse Road. Proceed to dam.

and Clean Transportation policy makers into a forum that will help enable the mass production of electric vehicles.

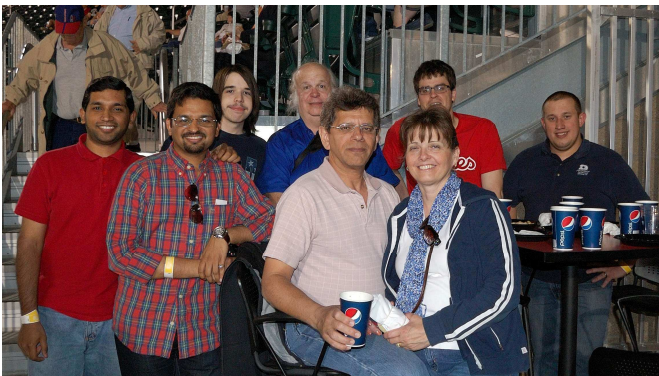
