Mr. Ben Tabatowski-Bush has been working on Alternative Powered Vehicle Electronics since 1992. His achievements include the creation of the Battery Controller for the Ford Electric Ranger program, the electronic architecture for upcoming Ford Hybrid battery systems, and numerous alternative vehicle powertrain systems such as 42V and 12V Integrated Started Alternator and 300V Traction Inverter. Ben graduated from the University of Michigan in 1989 with a BSEE and from Michigan State University in 1991 with a MSEE. He is currently employed by the Ford Motor Company in the Hybrid Vehicle Battery portion of the Research & Advanced department.
