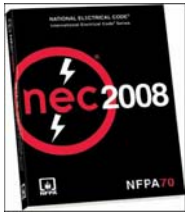


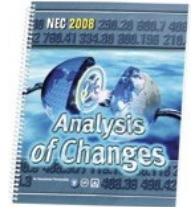

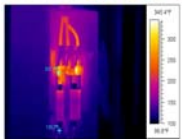
# 2008 National Electrical Code (NEC®) Analysis of Changes

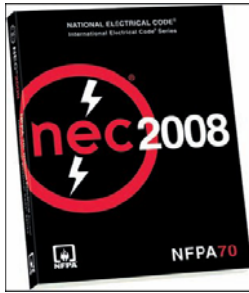

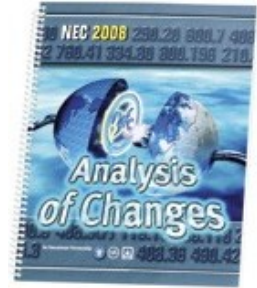
