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Subject: Grounding and Bonding - National Electrical Code Considerations

Grounding and bonding is a subject that is critical to the safe design of power distribution systems and a good understanding of it is necessary for an engineer to properly apply electrical products. National Electrical Code Article 250 is often difficult to understand without extensive experience and training, so it is always valuable to be able to attend a discussion of the subject by an expert. Join us for review of the theory and practice of grounding and bonding in accordance with the NEC by an experienced electrical inspector who has taught the subject.
