

Subject: Fire Alarm Systems in CA and SF

This presentation is centered around the design and installation of fire alarm systems in California and San Francisco. Presented will be such topics as "Occupancy Code Requirements", "Fire Alarm System Wiring and Configuration", "Fire Alarm System Components, Uses and Installation", "Interfacing Fire Alarm Systems with Other Building Systems" including Smoke Control, the "Requirements for System Testing and Commissioning" and "Plan Approval Guidelines".

He is also involved with regulatory agencies to establish equivalent facilitation and compliance with codes and standards that affect the fire alarm industry.
