In our last (Sept. 2003) newsletter to Life members, we enclosed a survey sheet intended to get to know what type of services and activities they like to see the Toronto Section offer in order to make the LM Chapter more responsive to the members' needs.

We are pleased and thankful to those 43 members who responded by e-mail, Fax and regular mail. The following is a summary of the replies:

1. 36 confirmed their address to be correct - 6 gave their address - 1 did not reply to this question
2. 38 confirmed renewal of their IEEE free membership - 4 did not renew - 1 was not sure
3. 37 do not need help to renew their registration - 6 declined
4. 32 are using the Internet - 11 not
5. 30 have e-mail address - 12 don't - 1 did not respond to this question
6. 26 gave their e-mail addresses - 1 declined
7. 28 don't need any help with using their computers - 6 need some sort of help – balance did not respond to this question
