The Chapter Activities in 2005

1. The Membership Development

The total membership of the Georgian Chapter was counted the 22 IEEE members in 2005. The EDS subsidized the 6 members with its MFS Program, the rest of them were self payers.

2. Technical and Organizational Activities

During this period five seminars have been held in Georgian Chapter (see attached forms L31). Also five meetings have been held on which the following questions were discussed and the following decisions were performed:

- The question of preparation of papers to the VIth International Symposium on Electromagnetic Compatibility and Electromagnetic Ecology (EMC-2005), which was held in June, has been considered.
- The question of candidature for the participation in Symposium EMC-2005 has been considered. It has been decided to send the Chapter member Dr. D. Kakulia at this Symposium.
- The papers preparation to the 2005 IEEE AP-S International Symposium, which was held in Washington DC, USA on July 3-8, 2005, has been discussed.
- The paper preparation to the Symposium “Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory”, which was held in Lviv, Ukraine on September 12-15, 2005, has been discussed.
- The papers preparation to the Workshop “Microwaves, Radar & Remote Sensing” which was held in Kiev, Ukraine on September 19-21, 2005, has been discussed.
- The question of candidature for the participation in mentioned above Symposium has been considered. It has been decided to send the Chapter Chair Prof. Revaz Zaridze to the 2005 IEEE AP-S International Symposium and Chapter members Dr. D. Kakulia and Dr. G. Ghvedashvili to the Symposium “Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory” and the Workshop “Microwaves, Radar & Remote Sensing”.
- The question of candidature for the participation in the MTT-S Chapter Chairs' Meeting Reg.8 in Paris has been considered. It has been decided to send Dr. T. Gogua at this meeting.
- Preparation of Georgian Chapter’s activity report for the mentioned above meeting has been discussed.
- The rotation of IEEE Georgian Chapter members for 2006 year had been discussed and was held. 10 members were elected to support by the AP MFS Program.
- Elections of Chapter Officers for the next term were performed on December 2005. The Chapter Chair Prof. R. Zaridze and The Chapter Treasurer Dr. D. Karkashadze were re-elected, Dr. David Kakulia was elected to post of Chapter vice Chair and Dr. Tamar Gogua was elected to post of Chapter Secretary.

As well as the last years the Georgian Chapter and its Management make efforts to disseminate information on the scope of the IEEE activity, deliver seminars and lectures devoted to scientific achievements in various field of technology, distribute periodicals, exerting thereby feasible assistance to Georgian scientific institutions. This Chapter activity gives Georgian scientists an opportunity of preparing projects to participate in various scientific international programs and thereby to integrate into the international scientific community. For example, today several tens of scientific subjects have been approved and funded under the auspices of ISTC, CRDF/GRDF, NATO Science for Peace Program, Eurocommission Programs.

Also Georgian Chapter involves students in order to organize the Student Branch to get benefits, which IEEE provides to student members.

Now we are on the way of organization the Transasiatic Subsection together with the scientists of Armenia and Azerbaijan. This year Armenia has 8 Active members and Azerbaijan has 5 Active members. We proposed them to joint into Chapters – Armenia

Chapter and Azerbaijan Chapter. And then, together with our Chapter organize the Transasiatic Subsection.
