1. The Membership Development

The total membership of the Georgian Chapter was counted the 19 IEEE members in 2015. Partially members were self-payers / or supported by Chapter.

2. Technical and Organizational Activities

During this period five technical meetings have been held in Georgian Chapter. Information about these meetings was submitted with electronic L31 meeting report form via vTools. Two meetings have been held on which the following questions were discussed and the following decisions were performed:

- Elections of Chapter Officers performed on January 8th. Following members were re-elected for the following positions: Dr. Prof. Kakhaber Tavzarashvili - Chapter Chairman, Dr. Prof. Giorgi Ghvedashvili - Chapter vice Chair, Dr. Tamar Gogua – Secretary/Treasurer;

- The preliminary schedule of technical meetings as well as Chapter Members activity for the next term has been discussed and confirmed. Information regarding performed technical meetings was uploaded at the IEEE vTools;
- The official web site of Georgian Chapter was renewed;
- Preparation to the Seminar/Workshop “Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory” was discussed. The official web site of 2015 International Seminar/Workshop Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory was renewed.
- A meeting on preparation of poster showing Georgian Chapter’s activity for MTT Chapter Chairs' Meeting Reg.8. Chapter Secretary/Treasurer Dr. Tamar Gogua has participated in CCM on September 7, 2015.
- Seminar/Workshop “Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory”, was held on September 21-24, 2015, at the Pidstryhach Institute for Applied Problems in Mechanics and Mathematics, NASU, Lviv, Ukraine. Chapter Chair and Vice-Chair have participated in the seminar.
- Chapter Annual Report was prepared.

Traditionally the Georgian Chapter and its Management make efforts to disseminate information on the scope of the IEEE activity, deliver seminars and lectures devoted to scientific achievements in various field of technology, exerting thereby feasible assistance to Georgian scientific institutions.

The workshop provides an opportunity to exchange scientific results and current research progress in the area of electromagnetics, electrodynamics, antennas and acoustics theory and applications. The Seminar/Workshop is organized by both the IEEE MTT/ED/AP/CPMT/SSC West Ukraine Chapter and MTT/ED/AP Georgia Chapter. Technical sponsors include the IEEE Electron Devices Society, Microwave Theory and Techniques Society and Antenna and Propagation Society.
