

Georgian IEEE-MTT/ED/AP/EMC Chapter Annual Report, 2002

During year 2002 four meetings has been held in Georgian Chapter on which the following questions were discussed and the following decisions were performed:

- Reelections of Chapter Officers have been performed on January 2002. The Chapter Chair Prof. R. Zaridze, The Chapter Treasurer Dr. D. Karkashadze, The Chapter Vice Chair Dr. Z. Tchakhnakia and Secretary Dr. N. Khuchua had been re-elected for next term.
- A meeting on preparation of Georgian Chapter's paper for 2002 ADCOM Meeting has been held on January 2002.
- The question of a candidature for the participation in this Meeting has been considered on May 2002. It has been decided to send the Chapter Chair Prof. R. Zaridze at ADCOM Meeting-2002 in San Antonio, USA. Prof. Revaz Zaridze had attended the meeting in San Antonio and presented Georgian Chapter report.
- The preparation of The Symposium "Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory", which had to hold in Tbilisi on 10-14 October 2002, has been discussed.
- Prof. Revaz Zaridze has attended the meeting in San Antonio on June 16-21, 2002 and presented Georgian Chapter report.
- The Symposium "Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory" has been held on October 10-14, 2002.
- The results from ADCOM Meeting-2002 in San Antonio had been acquainted and afterwards the Chapter's further activity was discussed.
- Results from Symposium "Direct and Inverse Problems of Electromagnetic and Acoustic Wave Theory" have been discussed.
- The rotation of IEEE Georgian Chapter members for 2003 year had been discussed and was held. 10 members were elected to support by the new MFS Program and question of the participating in the annual EDS Chapter Subsidy Program were discussed.
- Scientific and technical information in the field of semiconductor technology (Tbilisi State University, Tbilisi Technical University, Institute of Cybernetics, Institute of Metallurgy of the Georgian Academy of Sciences, etc.) has been obtained and disseminated.

- On May 26, 2002, on the Day of Independence of Georgia, a presentation took place at the Research and Production Complex (RPC) "Electron Technology" of Tbilisi State University, engaged in scientific and applied research in the field of gallium arsenide (GaAs) integrated circuits (IC) and semiconductor devices. President of Georgia, Mr. Eduard Shevardnadze was an honored guest at this presentation. Members of Government, Ambassador of Germany in Georgia and honored foreign guests from Fraunhofer-Institut fuer Angewandte Festkoerperphysik (Germany), Science for Peace Programme (SfP) NATO-HQ (Brussels, Belgium) were also present.
