You pay: 50% of your current dues/assessments • 50% of your Society dues for any Society you have belonged to for at least 5 years • 75% of the cost of the publications for those Societies • All other publications and Society memberships of less than 5 years must be paid in full.

- UNEMPLOYED** If you are unemployed through involuntary termination and are actively seeking employment, you pay 50% for all dues/assessments, Society dues and publications.

- MINIMUM INCOME** If your 2002 annual income (gross, unadjusted income including all benefits and services from any source) did not exceed US\$11,000, you pay: 50% of your current dues/assessments • 50% of one Society (your choice) and its optional publications. Please specify below.
