Mission in 2009

R10 Distinguished Large/Small Section Awards

- To recognize the excellent work of the Section in the prior year
- Evaluation based on the Section Annual report
- Large Section: Membership ≥ 501 as of 31 Dec of the prior year
- Small Section: Membership ≤ 500 as of 31 Dec of the prior year
- Recipients selected and notified: End of June
- A certificate and US\$1,000 awarded to the recipient sections
- R10 Director will present the certificate to the recipient sections at the annual R10 Committee Meeting of the next year
- The recipient sections will be also nominated to MGA Outstanding Large and Small Section Awards

R10 Outstanding Volunteer Award

- To to recognize the excellent work and contribution of outstanding volunteer to the Section
- Call for nominations: End of August
- Nomination deadline: End of October
- Recipients selected and notified: End of November
- A certificate will be presented to the recipients.
- One of the recipients will be invited to attend the Region 10 Committee Meeting of the next year with the travel expenses to be supported by R10, where the award certificate will be presented by the Region 10 Director.
- Award certificates for other recipients will be sent to the Section Chairperson for the presentation at an appropriate event of the Section.

R10 GOLD Award

- To recognize those substantive project or achievement of a relatively short nature but which have left an undeniable imprint on the fabric of GOLD operations within Region 10
- One award annually
- Call for nominations: End of June
- Nomination deadline: End of August
- Recipients selected and notified: End of October
- A representative of the award recipients will be invited to attend the Region 10 Committee Meeting of the next year with the travel expenses to be supported by R10, where the award certificate will be presented by the Region 10 Director.
