4. Welcome Address by Region 10 Director, Yong Jin Park

Director, Yong Jin Park, welcomed all section chairs, council chairs, VIPs from IEEE HQ and members. He also presented R10 status and its vision of more benefits to members, higher grade membership and more care for sections/chapters.

5. Address by IEEE President/Address by IEEE President-Elect, Moshe Kam

IEEE President, Pedro Ray, could not attend the meeting due to emergency and IEEE President-Elect, Moshe Kam, made a speech in lieu of Pedro Ray and for himself. Moshe Kam shared the method of expanding IEEE's technical reach, providing value to members, expanding IEEE's geographical reach and structural reform. He addressed focusing on expanding IEEE into new technical areas. He also mentioned renewing efforts on membership value and important opportunities in Regions 8-10.

6. Address by VP-MGA, Barry Shoop

VP-MGA, Barry Shoop, presented MGA missions and visions. He also implemented membership, 2010 MGA priorities and the method of focusing on members.

7. Address by R8 Director, Jozef Modelski

Region 8 director, Jozef Modelski, overviewed activities of Region 8 which are Europe, Africa, and Middle East. He mentioned 125th anniversary celebrations(Munich, April 27th, 2009), annual contests and conferences.

8. Address by IEEE BOD Treasurer, Peter Staecker

IEEE Treasurer, Peter Staecker, addressed 2009 financial performance. Investments, reserves, operating businesses and revenue were historically reviewed.

9. Address by IEEE Executive Director, James Prendergast

Executive Director, James Prendergast, mentioned that trends of key IEEE product sales, membership, standards, IEEE. Tv 2.0, IEEE Xplore 3.0 and IEEE Technology Navigator 2.0. He presented his top priorities and to do list for the next 90 days.

10. Announcements of R10 Awarded Sections' Posters, Norman Mariun

12 Sections placed their posters of activities performed for 125th anniversary celebrations during coffee break.

11. Announcement on the slate of R10 Director-Elect Candidates, Janina Mazierska

R10 past director, Janina Mazierska, reported on 2010 election of R10 Director. Three Nominees, Jose B. Cruz, Ramakrishna Kappagantu, Toshio Fukuda, were selected as candidates for election.

12. Presentation of Robert's Rules of Orders (Lawrence Wong)

Lawrence W.C. Wong, presented the latest version of Robert's Rules of Orders. The order of business, meeting process, regional committee, rules for debate, decision and voting procedures were reviewed.

Reports

13. Report on the Region 10 EXCOM Meeting in Brunei, 10 Jan. 2010 (Kukjin Chun)

Regional Secretary, Kukjin Chun, addressed that attendees, agenda, SSVR(125th anniversary), scopes of IEEE Region 10 EXCOM Meeting in Brunei, 10 Jan. 2010.

There were no comments on R10 EXCOM Meeting reports held in Brunei, 10 Jan. 2010.

14. Approval of Minutes of the R10 Meet in Hanoi, 28 Feb. 2009 (Kukjin Chun)

Minutes of R10 meeting in Hanoi, 28 Feb. 2009, was approved by meeting without amendments.

15. 2009 Finance Report by R10 Treasurer (Hang-Bong Kang)

A presentation was made by Treasurer, Hang-Bong Kang, who highlighted the following –

- General resource was 339,048 USD, Expenditure was 384,823 USD and Balance was -45,775 USD.

16. Audit Report for 2009 Finance (Akinori Nishihara)

Strategic Planning Coordinator, Akinori Nishihara reported that all records in the finance report are accurate and in good order, but there are a few traveling claims which are more expensive than others with similar routes and delegates should book their flights well in advance and choose economical tickets.

17. Presentation of 2010 Budget by R10 Treasurer (Hang Bong Kang)

Treasurer, Hang Bong Kang, presented 2010 budget. He tried to make a balanced budget for 2010, but overspending budget was inevitable due to economic situation. The total budget of 2010 will be 378,790 USD.

18. Sections' Reporting to HQ (Fanny Su)

Fanny Su, IEEE Asia-Pacific Office Manager, mentioned sections' reporting to HQ. She urged section to submit activity and financial report soon.

19. Presentation of Reports by EXCOM Members

Detailed reports by EXCOM Members will be available at R10 website.

(a) Awards and Recognition (Takatoshi Minami)

A presentation was made by Regional Awards & Recognition Committee Chair, Takatoshi Minami, who highlighted the following –

- Taipei section won the 2008 R10 Distinguished Large Section Award and Kharagpur Section was the 2008 R10 Distinguished Small Section Award winner.
- Ruey-Beei Wu (Taipei Section), Arun Agarwal (Hyderabad Section) and Walter Lachs (New South Wales Section) won the R10 Outstanding Volunteer Award for 2009.

(b) Regional Section (Norman Mariun)

Norman Mariun, Regional Section Coordinator, presented about R10 section status report, officer reporting and section rebate schedule for 2010. Korea council, Shandong subsection and Tasmania subsection were formed in 2009.

(c) Regional Chapter (Deepak Mathur)

A presentation was made by Regional Chapter Coordinator Deepak Mathur highlighting the statistics related to chapters in Region10. 33 new Chapters/joint Chapters were formed in 2009. He suggested two prong approach for sections - rejuvenate inactive chapters and form new chapters in potential technical societies where required number of members already exist. He also gave an emphasis on establishing link between chapters, societies and region to reap maximum benefits provided by societies to chapters.

Chapter coordinator requested sections to appoint a Chapter Promotion Volunteer in their sections for efficient and effective management of their chapters.

(d) Membership Development (Phingzhi Fan)

A presentation was made by Chengdu Section Chair, Phingzhi Fan, substitute Zhisheng Niu. The highlights are as follows:

- R10 Membership was reviewed, which shows increasing of new members.
- Best sections with highest retention and recruitment were mentioned.
- Incentive program and budget for 2010 was presented.

(e) Regional Conference (Marzuki Khalid)

A presentation was made by Regional Conference Coordinator, Marzuki Khalid, who highlighted the following –

- Activities of R10 conference
- Past TENCON events and future TENCON events.
- Host for TENCON 2012 has been awarded to Philippines Section.
- R10 has technically co-sponsored 4 conferences and supported 2 other conferences.

(f) Educational Activities (Proadpran Punyabukkana)

A presentation was made by Educational Activities Coordinator Proadpran Punyabukkana. The highlights are as follows:

- Received 21 proposals and granted support funds to every project \$300 for each project and \$200 for TISP from 12sections/chapters.
- Promoting the use of existing EAC resources.
- Proposing to compile new resources from new trainings/symposiums/colloquiums (can be focused on the strategic fields of IEEE interest).

(g) Technical Activities (Toshio Fukuda)

A presentation was made by Technical Activities Coordinator Toshio Fukuda and he highlighted the following –

- 7 Technical activities seminars were held in 2009.

(h) Newsletter (Zia Ahmed)

A presentation was made by Newsletter Editor, Zia Ahmed, who highlighted the following –

- The important role of strengthening the fabric of R10 family by the IEEE R10 newsletter.
- Topics currently covered or not covered by the IEEE R10 newsletter.

(i) Individual Benefits & Service, Financial Advantage Program (Hidenori Nakazato)

Hidenori Nakazato, Electronic Communications Coordinator, presented new benefits for R10 and currently under considerations. He also mentioned IEEE Financial Advantage Program (FAP).

(j) Electronic Communications (Hidenori Nakazato)

Hidenori Nakazato, Electronic Communications Coordinator, presented R10 Website update plan for 2010; Search capability, timely posting, some mechanisms for tighter interaction among sections, student branches, and EXCOM members.

(k) Life Member (Jung-Sun Kim)

Jung-sun Kim, Life Member Coordinator, presented current status and goals. The followings are highlights.

- About 970 Life Members in R10
- Current status: 2Life Member groups (Bombay section, new South Wales section), about 21 sections with more than 10 life members.
- The goal of 2010 is to encourage activation of Life Member Committee, membership of the Regional Life Members Committee is made up from the Life Member Group Chairs in their respective Sections.

(l) Strategic Planning (Akinori Nishihara)

A presentation was made by Strategic Planning Coordinator Akinori Nishihara. The highlights are as follows:

- Strategic Planning of R10 was analyzed in terms of SWOT method.
- He mentioned objectives of subsection and section, key points of strategic planning session.

(m) Industry Liaison (Jhing-Fa Wang)

Jhing-Fa Wang, Industry Liaison Coordinator, presented vision and activities in 2009, goals for year 2010 and activities for year 2010.

- Goals for year 2010: Enhance academia-industry collaboration, create benefits for academia-industry partnership to achieve innovations, increase more members from industry.

(n) Student Activities I (Takao Onoye)

A presentation was made by Student Activities Coordinator Takao Onoye and he highlighted

the following –

- Growth of R10 student activities were reviewed by increasing number of student branches and members.
- Regular activities and special initiatives for 2010.

(o) Student Activities II (Om Perakash)

A presentation was made by Student Representative Om Perakash and he highlighted the following –

- Regular student activities, challenges, special initiatives in 2009.
- 2010 plans: Enhancing networking among branches via GINI, Branch operations guide update & distribute.

(p) Women in Engineering (Ramalatha Marimuthu)

A presentation was made by Women in Engineering Representative Ramalatha Marimuthu. The highlights are as follows:

- Encourage: women education in general and engineering education in particular
- Empower: engineering women to take up leadership roles
- Enhance: IEE membership and visibility in public

(q) Regional GOLD (Helene Fung Hoi-Ying)

A presentation was made by Regional GOLD Program Representative Helene Fung Hoi-Ying and she highlighted the following –

- Current R10 GOLD affinity groups are 22(up from 21 a year ago).
- R10 GOLD activities and achievements in 2009
- Goals and activities for 2010

(r) Humanitarian Technology Challenge (Amarnath Raja)

A presentation was made by Humanitarian Technology Challenge Coordinator Amarnath Raja and he highlighted the following –

- 2009 Activities: eNotice, R10 HTC website, Facebook, meetings and conferences.
- Plans 2010: main workshop in Trivandrum.

(s) Professional Activities (Y.W. Liu)

A presentation was made by Professional Activities Coordinator Y.W. Liu and he highlighted the following –

- The purpose of the new initiative: inventory and assess the current state of Professional Activities within IEEE/ compile data on member interests and preferences related to Professional Activities, their management and financing/ develop a strategic plan to assist all regions in developing Professional Activities tailored to their specific needs and interests.

(t) R10 Advisory committee (Janina Mazierska)

Regional past director Janina Mazierska introduced about R10 advisory committee.

- Report: globalization of IEEE
- Plans for 2010: Assist and to advise Region 10 Director/ R10 and New Sections when&where needed/ Continue Push for Globalisation of IEEE and a better representation of

R10/ Assist in Increasing Nominations for IEEE Boards and Committee/ Organise IEEE Talks in Cambodia and Laos Push for better Visibility of IEEE in R10/ Coach Future IEEE Leaders of R10.

(u) Public Visibility & Tagline, One Voice Video, Tagline Video (Zia Ahmed)

A presentation was made by Newsletter editor Zia Ahmed and he highlighted the following –

- Defining and Mission: increasing public understanding of how engineering, computing & technology benefit humanity.
- 3 Central Components: 10 countries, 4 audiences, 6 hot topics

- TENCON 2009 will be held at Fukuoka International Congress Center on 21st -24th November, 2010.
- Sumo Tournament at the next building Kyushu Round Season is November 14 –28, 2010

27. Presentation on TENCON 2011(Indonesia Section)

A presentation TENCON 2011 was made by Indonesia section secondary delegates Wahidin Wahab. It will be held in Inna Grand Bali Beach Hotel, Resort & Spa on 21st -24th, November, 2010.

28. Presentation on TENCON 2012(Philippines Section)
