A.1 Executive Summary

- **Chapters:** MG-S (Magnetics Society) Nagoya Chapter was established.
The chair is Prof. Dr. Satoshi Iwata (Nagoya University)
- **Section activity:** A number of activities were organized by Nagoya Section in 2008. Total 26 events including 22 lectures in the areas of dielectric/insulation materials, antennas, robotics and IT, etc. were held successfully.
- **Milestones:** Nagoya section proposed two milestones, Yosami Radio Transmitting Station and Pioneering Achievements in TV Development, to the IEEE History Center. Yosami Radio Transmitting Station was approved.
- **Membership activity:** Nagoya section had the following members: Fellow: 30, Senior Member: 47, Member: 796, Associate Member: 67, Student Member: 114, Total: 1054 in Dec. 2008.
