## 1. Eligibility

The entrant must be a member of an official IEEE Student Branch.

## 2. Number of Entries

### 2.1 Entries per School

There shall be no limit to the number of papers one school submits to the competition.

### 2.2 Entries per Student

There will be a limit of one T-Shirt design submitted per student.

## 3. Design Requirements

### 3.1 Must Haves

**IEEE logo must be incorporated into the design.** Each submitted design must have a unique name. The T-Shirt Competition committee reserves the right to withhold any design with a name deemed inappropriate from the competition. The design must use two colors.

### 3.2 Profanity

Elements of the design may not contain any profanity, offensive language or offensive graphics. The T-Shirt Competition committee reserves the right to withhold any design deemed inappropriate from the competition.

## 4. Design Submission

### 4.1 Digital Upload

A **digital upload** (i.e. PDF, JPEG, PNG) of the finished design is required, and may be submitted at this [link](#). The digital upload submission deadline is **Sunday, March 4th, 2018**.

### 4.2 Public Voting Period

Once the design has been submitted, a voting time period will begin, where students' peers will vote on the design they think best represents the 2018 IEEE Student Activities Conference.

The voting deadline will be on **Sunday, March 11th, 2018**. Design submissions will be anonymous to voters, in hopes of discouraging biased voting. Voters will be asked to select their top 3 designs. In the case of a tie, the T-Shirt Design Committee reserves the right to decide which design they believe is best.
