Part-time volunteers are needed for the Electricity and Electronics Merit Badge Booths at the 15th National Scout Jamboree. IEEE is the title sponsor of the Electronics Merit Badge Booths and co-sponsor of the Electricity Merit Badge Booths. Volunteers are primarily needed for the position of merit badge instructor. While part-time volunteers can volunteer for just one day, it is preferred that they volunteer for at least two days in order to improve the quality of instruction to the scouts.

Jamboree Location

The 2001 Jamboree will be held at Fort A. P. Hill near Bowling Green, Virginia. Bowling Green is between Richmond and Fredericksburg. This 76,000-acre U.S. Army facility has served as the permanent site for the National Scout Jamboree since 1981.
