
Issue Flow for Sections Congress 2005 Last update: 14 March 2005



Publicity of Sections Congress 2005 Process. Informal or formal discussion of issues.

Region attendees finalize their recommendations and reduce them to a maximum of four recommendations if necessary.

A Region spokesperson presents the Region's recommendatons to the Congress.

Group the recommendations into ten issues (equal to number of issue caucuses)

Prior art (ongoing projects, information about what has been tried before, etc.) is prepared per issue area

Self-selected attendees attend specific caucus to create two focused recommendations for consideration by the congress.

Vote to rank issues into "top ten" issues to allow focused post-Congress attention to them. Keep the remaining issues as unranked pool so as to not lose them. Both sets will be published.
