## R3 Bylaws 60 day amendment rule – proposed change to 20 days

## BYLAWS FOR REGION 3 OF THE INSTITUTE of ELECTRICAL and ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS, Inc. (Adopted April 10, 1978; last amended April 07, 2002) ARTICLE I: PURPOSE AND SCOPE

Section 4: Amendments to these Bylaws shall be submitted by the Region 3 Executive Committee to all section chairs at least 20 days in advance of the Region 3 Committee meeting at which such amendments will be considered. A majority vote of the Region 3 Committee members present at the meeting is required for approval, provided a quorum is present

A mail vote may be taken provided that ballots are sent with the proposed amendments to all members of the Region 3 Committee at least 20 days before the required return date. A majority vote of the returned ballots is required for approval, provided that ballots are returned from at last half the sections in region 3. A ballot which is not returned shall not be counted as a vote either for or against the proposed amendment.

Amendments may be made by approval of a majority of the voting members of the Region in a referendum held as a result of a petition signed by one percent of the voting members of the region providing that a majority of the sections in the region are represented by one percent of their members on the petition.
