

Minutes of IEEE REGION 3 ExCom E-Conference

14 September 2009

Director Ratcliff welcomed everyone to the e-conference and thanked them for their participation. He reviewed the plans for the evening. The group used IEEE's Adobe ConnectPro Web Meeting service along with its conferencing bridge service with Skype, toll-free 1-888, and long distance dialing along with IRC and web pages to accomplish its work.

The agenda was reviewed and adopted including the consent agenda:

Discussion Agenda

- Secretary Green reported that the ExCom action of 6 June awarding the Jacksonville Section SoutheastCon exceeded the ExCom's authority. While the Region Committee did, at its March meeting authorize awarding the 2011 and 2012 SoutheastCon's there was no delegation regarding 2013. The ExCom action will be treated as a recommendation to the Region and a vote of the Region Committee will be sought.
- Director Ratcliff reviewed the Operations Manual for potential changes. The majority of these changes related to committee charters. He thanked Awards Chair Mary Ellen Randall for her submissions on this topic. He asked the Chairs of the various committees to codify these changes and submit them to him by the 25 September 2009.
- Charles Lord gave a brief report on training sessions as well as plans for the next one which will be 1:30 – 6:00 pm Eastern Time on September 26, 2009. He is planning to send out some "pre-meeting activities" for this second meeting. Using a slide presentation, he reviewed other leadership training efforts that are being done in conjunction with the MGA Center for Leadership Excellence project.
- Pat Donohoe and Matthew Erickson reported on the Region 10 Student Congress and IEEE Students Activities Meeting.

Conference Committee Chair Don Hill reported that SoutheastCon 2009 has a draft of its final report. He expects a slight surplus to be distributed to the Region as well as the Atlanta Section.

Having concluded the agenda, Director Ratcliff adjourned the meeting at 10:30pm EDT.
