




Metrics

ExCom Tweaks...



- Not staff MELC but move that Role to ExCom
 - Perhaps with Region Vice Chair (Director-Elect) responsible for ensuring it gets attention by the ExCom
- Declaring that all Section XYZ committee chairs are a member of the Region XYZ committee (and <u>expect</u> them to meet to share problems and solutions)
- Train and mentor our ExCom Committee chairs



Training (telling ain't training)

- Treat training as an engagement opportunity
- Ensure we include tool training
 - Doodle, Skype, IEEE Online Community, new SAMIEEE, Personalized Email Tool, Office Tasks, Engagement Advocacy
- Leverage IEEE CLE
 - Attendees who supply me a written critique of a CLE course they have taken will get an R3 memento (while supplies last)
