I thank all of the Section Chairs who are able to come and attend this Region meeting by teleconference. We need your participation to approve the slate of candidates for Region 3 Director-Elect/Delegate-Elect for 2014–15. We must accomplish this task before our next face-to-face meeting in Jacksonville, FL.

Super Storm Sandy caused quite a bit of damage along the east coast. Many IEEE staff members were personally affected. Additionally, the IEEE Operations Center went dark essentially running out of gas. As reported earlier, the cloud services were not impacted, IEEE XPIore and Spectrum Online were recovered to another facility as was the email alias system although it did not work well. The Board received two after event briefings of the events of the two weeks and will hear a full post mortem along with action items at a future meeting. I know that many Region 3 OUs were impacted by the non-availability of vTools and other IEEE services. Reviewing the service expectations, costs, and disaster recovery approach will be part of these later activities.

MGA has chosen its officers and committee members for 2013. Ralph Ford will be the new VP for Member and Geographic Activities. I expect a SCOOP to be distributed shortly with the committee members.
