This meeting will be chaired by the new IEEE Jamaica Section Chair, Dr. Dave Muir. The Excom Members are expected to be in attendance.

#### e-Membership

Jamaica is eligible for the IEEE e-membership programme.

The members were encouraged to utilize the early membership registration for 2013. Members who have not renewed this year, members who were found to be inactive and other interested persons will be contacted by email to extend to them the opportunity to utilize e-membership. We have seen positive results with the appointment of a new membership development chair (Christopher Udeagha) last year and we plan to continue to focus on this membership drive during the remainder of the year to improve our membership.

The section has responded positively to queries regarding forming a new Student Branch Chapter at the Northern Caribbean University (NCU). NCU has received significant acclamations after winning several Microsoft awards including The Microsoft Imagine Cup World Champion in 2010 - after placing 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2007.
