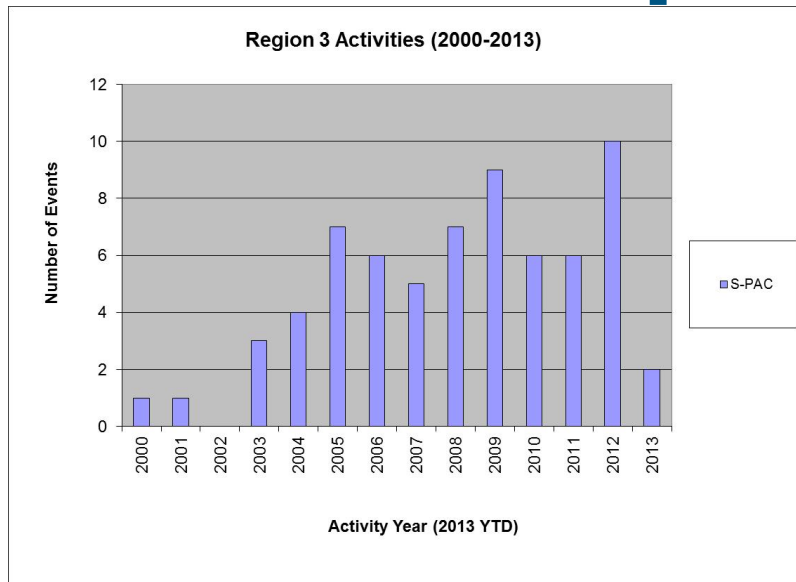


R3 SPAC Report and Plans



• Goals

- 1) Increase number of S-PACs held in R3.
- 2) Work with national SPAC to increase S-PAVs.
- 3) Inform all R3 Student Branches about S-PACs and ask them to commit to host at least one S-PAC during 2013.

• Status

- 1) Presented at SoutheastCon 2012
- 2) S-PACs have been held at :Georgia Institute of Technology 1/17/12; University of Technology, Jamaica 2/2/12; University of South Florida 4/14/12; University of Alabama, Birmingham 4/20/12; University of Kentucky 4/21/12; Virginia Tech 4/23/12; Christian Brothers University 4/27/12; Broward College 11/2/12; Florida Institute of Technology 11/30/12; University of South Florida 12/1/12; Georgia Institute of Technology 1/15/13; University of Central Florida 1/15/13;
- 3) Working w/SAC to coordinate training & communication.
- 4) Broward College is working on a S-PAVe March/April time frame and Virginia Tech is working on an S-PAC in March time frame.

- 1) Attended Student Leadership Workshops in Charlotte, NC, Birmingham, AL, and Orlando, FL to present S-PAC material.
- 2) Attend R3 ExCom meetings, keeping everyone up-to-date on all S-PAC/S-PAVe/S-PAW Region Activity. – Ongoing
- 3) Coordinate with Student Activities Committee. – Ongoing
- 4) Attend Student Leadership Workshop and Area Meetings at SoutheastCon 2013 in Jacksonville, FL
