On Wednesday February 27, 2013 the Section had a presentation on "The Scope of IEEE and the Impact on Jamaica." by Dr. Dave Muir, Chair, IEEE Jamaica Section. The meeting was held at the Engineering Conference Room, School of Engineering, UTech.

February's meeting was followed by another presentation on Wednesday March 27, 2013 by Farley Artwell, Chair IEEE UTech Student Branch entitled "The Design of an Ultra Wide Band Patch Antenna System to enhance Frequency Regulation in Jamaica." The presentation was well supported.

e-Membership

Jamaica is eligible for the IEEE e-membership programme.

The Jamaica Section SouthEastCon 2015 Committee members met on January 23, 2013 to discuss the requirements and outcome of the meeting between the IEEE Region 3 Conference Chairman, Sean Haynes on Wednesday January 17, 2013 regarding the Jamaica Section proposal for hosting SouthEastCon 2015. Sean gave significant guidance for organizing the Conference and also provided data and estimates that have proven very helpful in developing a budget for the hosting the Conference. The Committee has since re-confirmed the arrangements with the Hilton and is in the process of completing the budget estimates for hosting the conference. The remaining documents for final approval for Jamaica to host SouthEastCon 2015 is expected to be submitted at the next SouthEastCon meeting this month.

The Hilton confirmed that the dates for the Conference are available and have submitted a proposal to the Section. The Hilton has also extended an invitation to have R3 Conference Committee members enjoy a complimentary visit to the Hotel Resort.

Barriers:

At present the Section has a few core persons who are members of the ExCom that are very active and there are positions within the ExCom that need to be filled. The challenge is to have other IEEE members take on these leadership positions. However, new persons have been appointed to positions within the Excom for 2013 and it is expected that there will be increased participation over the course of the year.
