IEEE continues its rollout of IEEE Google Mail and related services to all members. The most recent milestone was the conversion of all forwarding accounts to Google, allowing those who had been forwarding to start using their Google mailbox, calendar, and drive (and other services) as well as a soft rollout of a new signup process for those who wish to use the tools. It has been reported that members are signing up at twice the rate as before the Google service was put in place even though there has no advertising has yet occurred. I believe we have an opportunity to turn this common system (mail, calendar, storage, authentication) into a great collaboration system for volunteers in members. I am involved in a few activities that are considering this and I am sure some of you have ideas on things we can do in Region 3 with these tools.
