As a Director, I have served on several IEEE Board Committees this year (SPC ad hoc, IEEE IT Advisory Ad Hoc, Social Networking for Professionals, Governance) as well as the MGA Board and the IEEE-USA Board.

IEEE's SPC Ad Hoc Committee has assisted the Board in Strategic Planning this year. Building upon a Mission / Vision / Core Values as shown in the Attached Infomedia Chart, they trying to think through steps that should be taken now to put IEEE in a good position no matter which of several global scenarios that play out.

My IT Advisory role led to membership in the Social Networking for Professionals led to a Board action to build Profession Productivity and Collaboration Tools. This project has the volunteer and staff support of most of the IEEE major OUs including MGA, PUBS, and TAB. The product will provide collaboration, authoring, research, chatting one-on-one and in communities, user created and IEEE created communities. We expect to announce it officially at the Sections Congress in August as well as include in 2015 membership year renewal.

IEEE hosted IEEEXtreme - a 24 hour software endurance contest. 68 Groups from Region 3 participated. Congrats to all as well as thanks to all who served to support this effort.

The Newsletter recently produced by our Editor Bill Labelle has my end of term reflections and commments. We have tried to increase member engagement such that the members of IEEE feel that there are reasons to belong and make a contribution. I thank Mary Ellen for keeping this in front of us over the two years through some great examples of success across our Region 3 groups. Hopefully, these good examples will inspire others in other OUs. Similarly we have tried to increase the useful training and tools available to sections through efforts at SoutheastCon, visits, and webinars. Mary Ellen plans us to move us to the next level in both of these areas – I'll leave it to her report and other media to elaborate.

We have several projects from the Region 3 Committee meeting in progress:

- 360 degree data (to/from local OUs)
- Better online tool for sections
- STEM Information
- Leadership Development and Training
- SoutheastCon Structure

We will ask the leaders of these projects to report them back to the Region Committee next March to close them out. Thanks to all who have been working on these.
