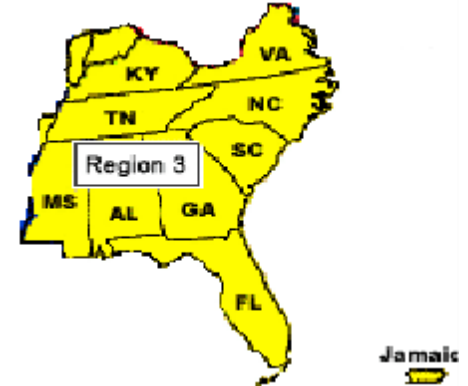
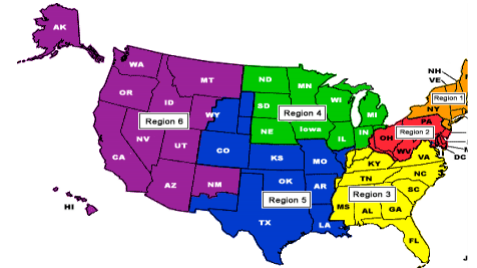

VISION

- The relationship with the member is changing from a customer to a partner.

- It is important to collect data on interactions with the member both for the present need and for future initiatives.

Review Region Conference Involvement

- Decide how the Region could provide expertise, financing and consistency working with local units to provide excellent conferences.

Share achievements and ideas with other areas of IEEE

Virtual Communities: Pursue tools available Institute wide for sharing and communications.
