I would like to first report that the South Carolina Council has been revitalized! Through the tireless work of Jacquelyn Cunningham, we have met and revitalized the council for the support of the state's (and area7's) sections. This occurred 28-June-2014 at USC in Columbia. Through extensive review of the current SC Council bylaws it was determined that we could appoint new officers (as section chairs and representatives) for the remainder of the year and work on bringing the bylaws into compliance with MGA guidelines.

Current officers are:

After appointing/approving these officers, we set forth the following tasks:

1. Create a nominating committee for officers for 2015.
2. Create a bylaw committee to create a new set of bylaws in compliance w/ MGA guidelines.
3. Get control of and balance the council bank account.
4. Consider new initiatives that will add value to the sections of South Carolina.
5. Contact the SC State Board of Engineering Examiners to lend our support.


Of these, all have been started and committees formed. The bank account has been signed over to David who has already balanced the account.

I received zip code data from IEEE staff, which they use to define section territories. Please see the attached PDF file.

-- Page 1 shows the territories of the three Area 3 sections (i.e., Atlanta, Central Georgia, and Savannah) and one section in the SC Council because part of that territory is in GA (i.e., Central Savannah River). Notice the irregularly defined boundaries of the Savannah Section territory.

-- Page 2 shows a zoomed view of the Savannah Section's boundary. Chris responded with a list of counties which he said their bylaws defined their territory.

-- Page 3 shows a view of the Savannah Section territory as defined by Chris' list, which looks a lot more reasonable. I have contacted the staff person that provided me with zip code lists to try to reconcile the two definitions. Will report back progress.

I have been participating on the special review committee study area chairs.

I have continued to reach out to contacts at Georgia Tech to begin engaging with other state-wide, or state-level, organizations involved with the engineering profession, but no "formal" meetings have been scheduled yet.

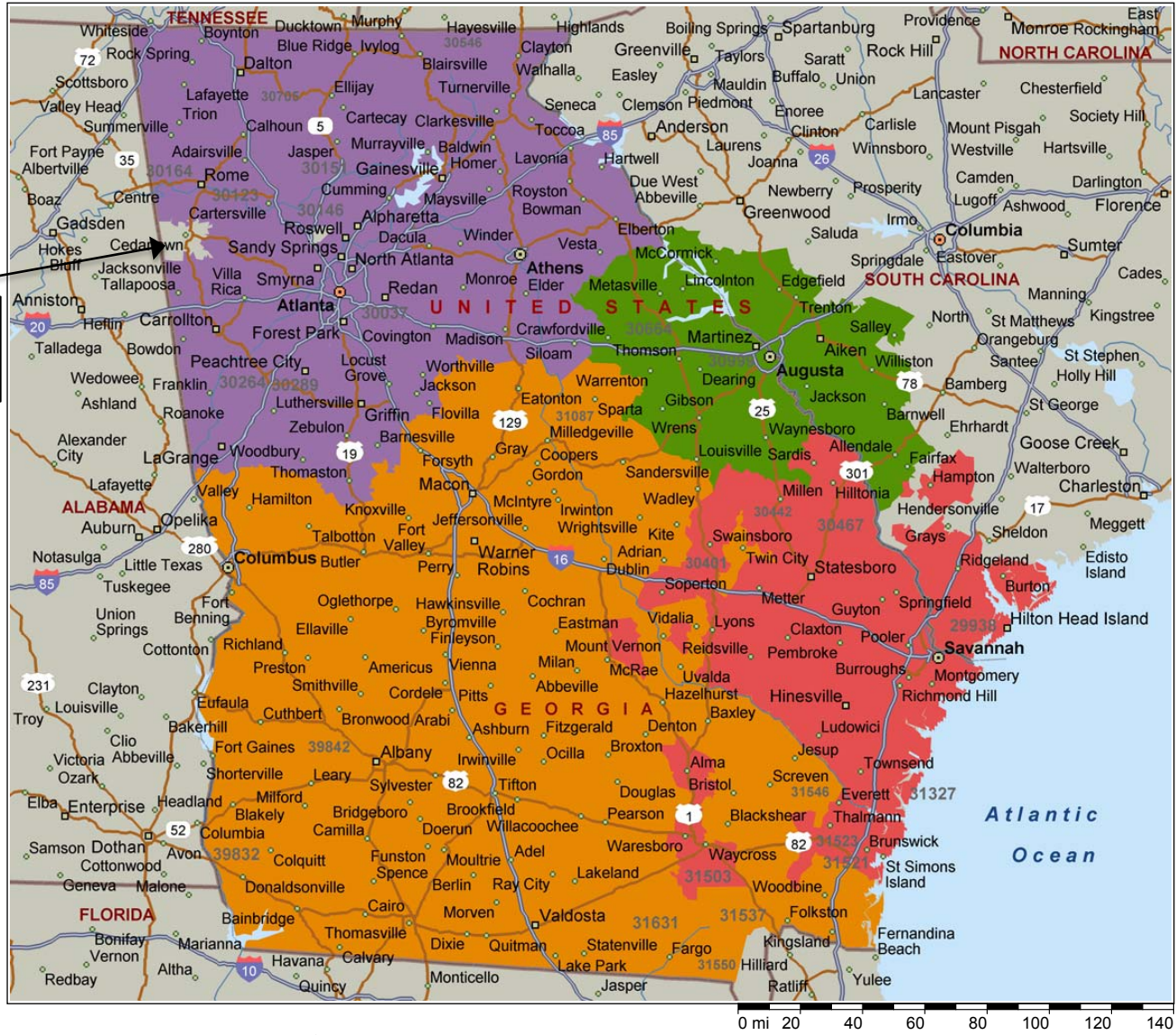

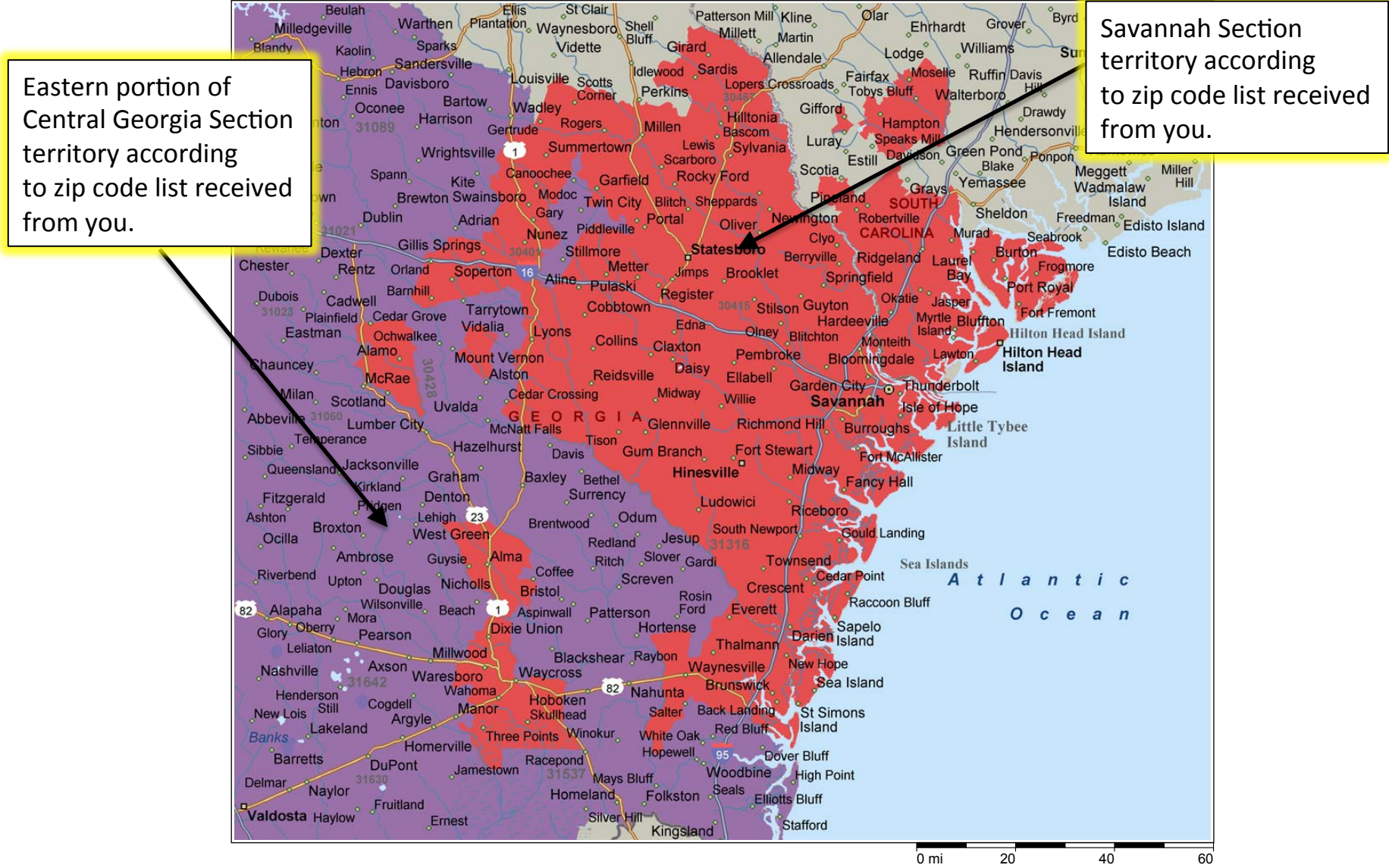

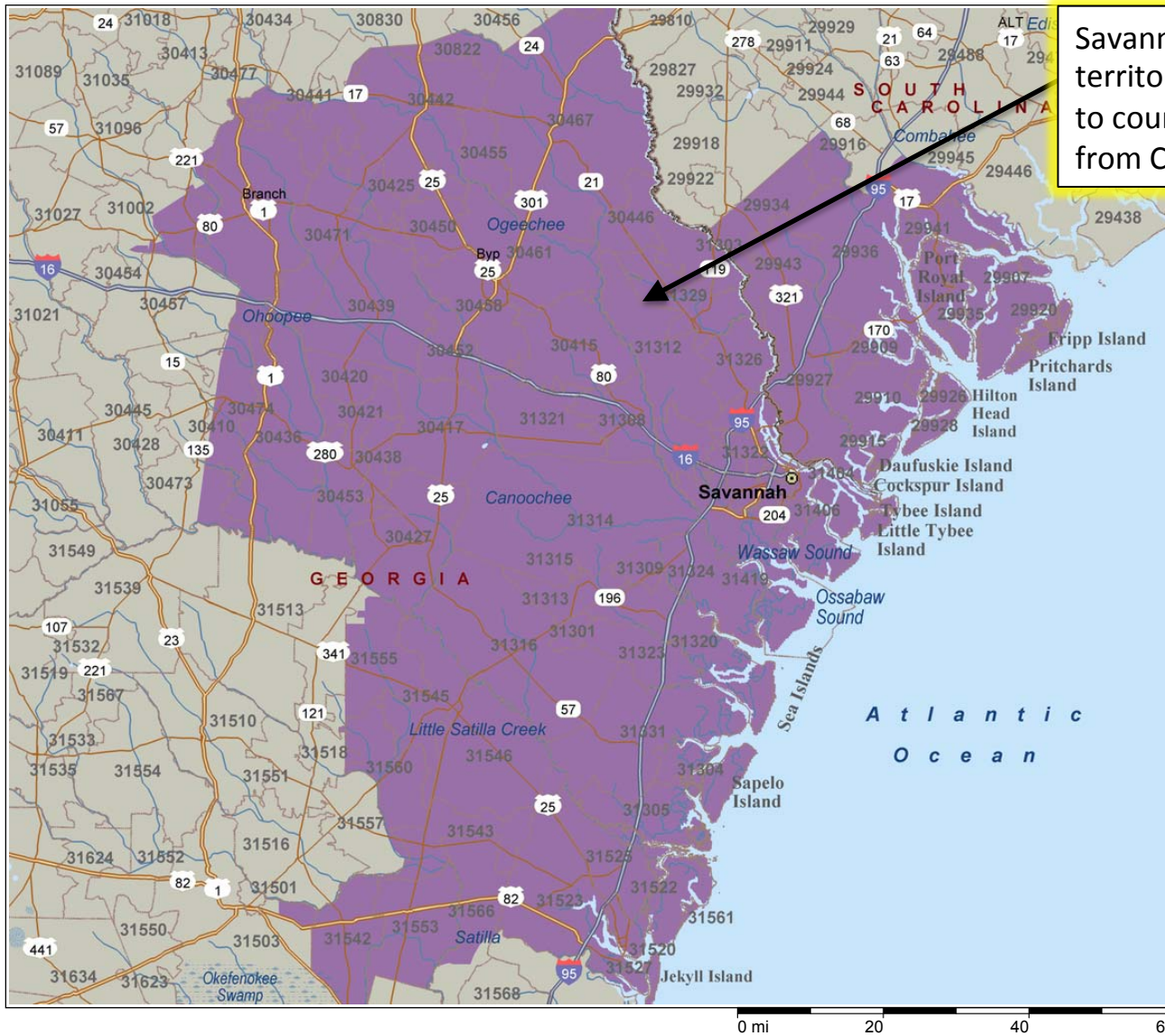
