### **2014 IEEE Mississippi Section Highlights**

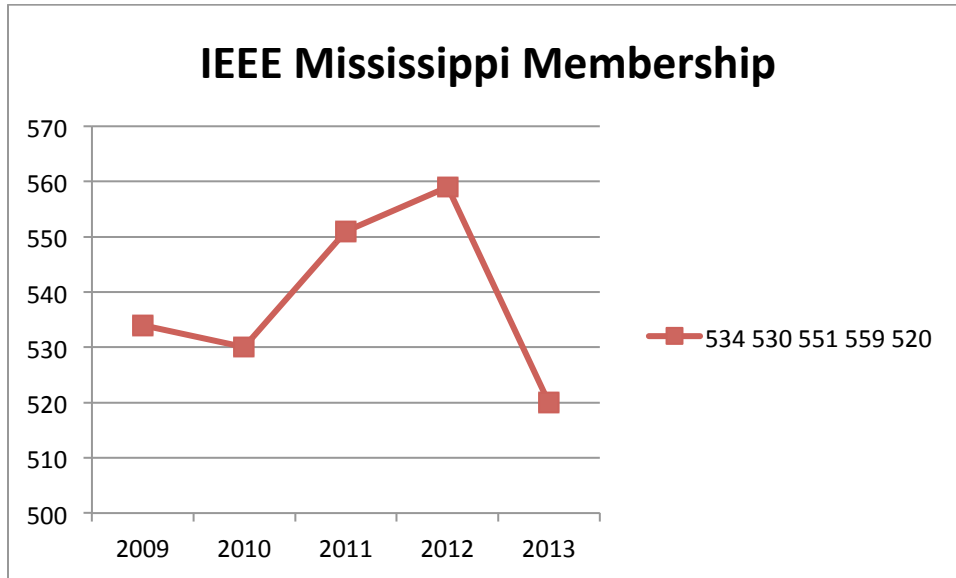
