The region 3 senior member elevation focus continues. We are at 80% of our yearly goal. If we can clean up all the applications pending referrals, we can meet our goal this year. This is a great way to engage members. REMEMBER, you do not have to know a candidate to provide an endorsement. You may indicate that you do not know the member, but explain that you have reviewed their resume (or interviewed them) and believe the experience applies. There is only 1 more review panel this year, so applications have to be completed ASAP. The review panel is on the 22nd and the HQ Staff is trying to take applications as long as they can. Let's make it easy on them.

Our 3 region special projects continue to progress. See the individual reports for VIP. First Year member experience, and MOVE. Last month, we received approval for \$65K towards the MOVE project from IEEE-USA. My plan is to try to raise the remaining funds during 4Q2014, so we can get it pulled together, starting in 1Q2015.
