The Area is in good condition and continues to seek opportunities to strengthen its constituent Sections, to bring benefits to its members and to implement agreed upon initiatives.

Accomplishments:

- The Area 7 Chair attended a very successful joint meeting of the Central Savannah River Section and the Savannah River Section of the International Society of Automation, in Augusta.
- The Piedmont Section hosted the 1st Quarter meeting of the IEEE SC Council in Greenville, South Carolina, on the campus of Bob Jones University.
- The Columbia Section hosted the 2nd Quarter meeting of the IEEE SC Council in Florence, South Carolina. The meeting was held in the facilities of the Southeastern Institute of Manufacturing and Technology, following a tour of the facility.
- The Coastal SC Section is actively planning to host the 3rd Quarter meeting of the Council.
- At least two Sections will host IEEE Day activities and all Sections will participate in Sections Congress.
- At the State-level (SC), the Council has filled one seat and is actively seeking members to fill two additional seats on the state-wide (SC) body that nominates seats for the engineering and professional surveyors oversight board in South Carolina.
- All Sections and the Council are aware of the need the meet requirements for IEEE nominations and elections processes.

Challenges:

- There appears to be a direct correlation between IEEE Student Branch engagement and IEEE dean/faculty engagement. Where there is little or no dean/faculty IEEE promotion, IEEE membership declines significantly.
