The LDRS Committee this year has been involved in presentations at SoutheastCon, and has submitted articles to the Region 3 Newsletter. Sections have been made aware on multiple occasions that they can contact the committee if they would like any type of volunteer training. Some interest was shown, but no Section has asked for any training assistance. Sean Haynes has been very actively working with Sections and R3 on planning for Sections Congress in Sydney.

Jill Gostin, LDRSC Chair, is serving on the MGA Training Committee, which has been working on redesigning and simplifying the Center for Leadership Excellence website. The website contains Action Plans for each position. Within the Action Plan, you will find what to do in your First 30 Days (along with links to resources/training), Key Administrative Items, and a list of things that should be done yearly. Also, there are recommended training modules broken down by category (e.g., Leadership, Management, IEEE Awareness, Business & Finance, etc.). Visit the [CLE website](#) and explore all of the information available. Select Volunteer (or explore the other areas), login, and select Volunteer again. The View Action Plans link is in the center of the page near the top (and instructions are to the left, near the top). There you will find the 30-day, Key Administrative Items, and Yearly tasks. Below the View Action Plans link, you will find a list of Volunteer Positions. Here you can find Recommended Training modules.
